The Thornflower - an image of reconciliation - by the artist Charlotte Mayer, donated to St Ethelburga's, unites opposing elements of thorns and flowers speaking of reconciliation, peace and oneness. Rooted in Charlotte's childhood and the death of her Grandmother in Treblinka in 1942, the sculpture reflects beyond the Nazi Holocaust on "man's inhumanity to man at other times".

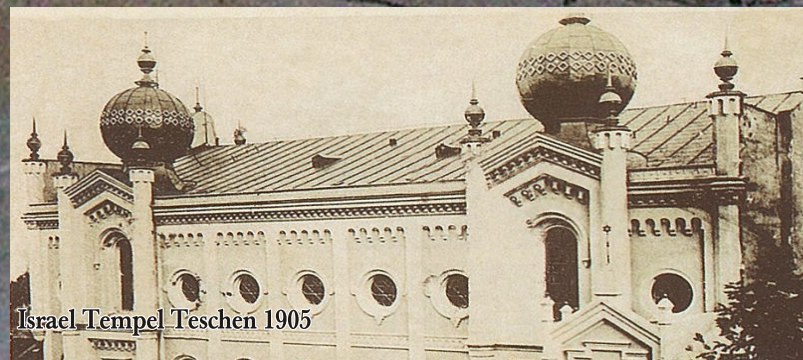
